The **Queen Elisabeth Music Chapel** is pleased to present its traditional **Gala Concert** on **April 17th** in the magnificent Henry Le Bœuf hall at **Bozar**.

This concert will be enhanced by the presence of **Their Majesties King Albert II and Queen Paola**, **Honorary Chairman of the Music Chapel** for 20 years, at the renewal of the institution.

An evening that will illustrate its strong values: excellence, transmission, and companionship aimed at raising high the young promising generations of musicians, at the heart of a unique worldwide project welcoming more than 30 nationalities every year.

Taking the spotlight on stage, **José van Dam** - Master in residence of the Music Chapel for 20 years for the singing section. In an unexpected but captivating role as the narrator of A *Midsummer Night's Dream*, he will be surrounded by the **Octopus** choir and two young singers: the Quebec soprano and Associate Artist **Carole-Anne Roussel** whose career is developing with great success both overseas and in Europe, and the talented French mezzosoprano **Anne-Lise Polchlopek**, Artist in residence.

The splendid violinist of Danish-Ukrainian origin and Artist in residence **Anna Agafia Egholm** will be the star of the first part in Beethoven's longest and only violin concerto: the D major.

Mentors and young talents will be accompanied by Appassionato, the excellent chamber orchestra created and directed by Mathieu Herzog for more than ten years.
