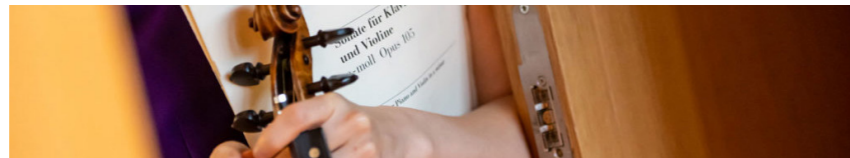

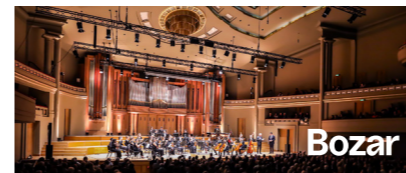

## Ikigai - Là où la musique rencontre le sens

Cette saison, la Chapelle Musicale Reine Elisabeth place, au cœur de sa quête d'excellence, *l'ikigai*, cet art de vivre venu du Japon qui nous invite à une recherche de sens à la fois intime et partagée. Ce fil invisible relie talent, exigence et raison d'être ; passion, quête de soi et sens profond. Dans un monde incertain, *l'ikigai* nous invite à ralentir, écouter, ressentir, et trouver l'équilibre entre élan artistique et place dans le monde. C'est dans cet espace que nous voulons voir nos Artistes en résidence se réaliser, explorant leur propre voie, guidés par des Maîtres en résidence toujours plus engagés. Notre saison *ikigai* célèbre l'essence des liens vivants : entre générations, cultures et disciplines, là où la musique dialogue avec la danse, la science, l'image ou la nature. Dans cet élan commun, chaque concert devient un moment d'écoute profonde – de soi, des autres, du monde – et une tentative musicale de répondre à une question (pas si) simple et pourtant essentielle : pourquoi faisons-nous ce que nous faisons ?

## Ikigai - Waar muziek betekenis krijgt

Dit seizoen plaatst de Muziekkapel Koningin Elisabeth de *ikigai* centraal in haar streven naar uitmuntendheid – die Japanse levenskunst die ons uitnodigt tot een zoektocht naar betekenis, zowel persoonlijk als gedeeld. Een onzichtbare draad verbindt talent, veeleisendheid en zingeving; passie, zelfontdekking en diepere betekenis. In een onzekere wereld nodigt *ikigai* ons uit om te vertragen, te luisteren, te voelen, en het evenwicht te vinden tussen artistieke drang en onze plaats in de wereld. Het is in die ruimte dat wij onze Artists in Residence willen zien groeien, hun eigen pad verkennend, begeleid door steeds meer toegewijde masters in residence. Ons *ikigai*-seizoen viert de essentie van levende verbindingen: tussen generaties, culturen en disciplines, waar muziek in dialoog gaat met dans, wetenschap, beeld of natuur. In dit gedeelde momentum wordt elk concert een moment van diepe luisterervaring – naar zichzelf, naar de ander, naar de wereld – en een muzikale poging om te antwoorden op een (niet zo) eenvoudige maar fundamentele vraag: waarom doen we wat we doen?
